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TK - 1st Grade Application Checklist

Children enrolled in the Early Education Center at Wesleyan and do NOT have a sibling enrolled in the Academy are required to tour or visit with the Admissions Office.

☐ Gesell Parent Questionnaire: As part of the online application, parents will be required to download the Gesell Parent Questionnaire, complete this form, and upload it back into the application prior to the online submission.
☐ Gesell Teacher Questionnaire: Download the Gesell Teacher Questionnaire and deliver it to your child's preschool teacher to complete. Once completed, please upload the Gesell Teacher Questionnaire into the application prior to the online submission.
Schedule the Gesell Developmental Observation / Meeting with Wesleyan Christian Academy faculty. This 30 to 45 minute assessment is required for all children applying to transitional kindergarten (TK), kindergarten (K), or first grade (1st). While your child is being assessed, potential parents will meet with our Elementary Principal in a group setting to learn more about this important placement tool.

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ADMISSIONS TESTING

Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and 1st-Grade Applicants

Wesleyan Christian Academy uses the Gesell Developmental Observation-Revised (GDO-R) to assess all applicants applying to transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, and first-grade. The assessment will take place during the spring prior to August enrollment and the results of the assessment will determine your child's placement in TK, K, or 1st-grade.

TK, K, and 1st Grade Gesell Testing Dates:

JAN 29, JAN 30, JAN 31, FEB 1, FEB 2, MAR 14, and MAR 15, 2024

TK and K Age Requirements

- Applicants applying for **transitional kindergarten (TK)** must turn 5 years old on or before OCT 31 <u>and</u> score a developmental age of 4.5 to 5 years old at the time of testing.
- Applicants applying for kindergarten (K) must turn 5 years old on or before AUG 31 and score a
 developmental age of 5 to 6 years old at the time of testing.

2nd - 12th Grade Applicants

Most applicants applying to Wesleyan's traditional Academy will sit for the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Test to verify they can perform at an academic level equivalent to our current students. MAP testing is a computerized assessment that will take place in a small group environment. Generally, our Admissions Committee is looking for applicants who score above the 70th percentile in the areas of Reading (2nd - 4th)/ English (5th-12th) and Math. MAP admissions testing may be waived in one of the following instances:

- The applicant can provide previous MAP scores (within the last quarter) from their current school.
- The applicant can provide previous standardized test scores from any national normed test with scores above the 90th percentile.

Enrichment Center Applicants

The Enrichment Center is a specialized, college-preparatory program for students with mild to moderate diagnosed learning differences and/or ADHD. We do not admit students who have primary behavioral or emotional disabilities, not can our program accommodate students with below average intellectual abilities. Applicants to the Enrichment Center at Wesleyan Christian Academy are required to sit for the Woodcock-Johnson (WJ) Test of Achievement or the Kaufman Test of Educational Achievement (KTEA). All enrichment testing is done in a one-on-one environment.

The cost of our optional breakfasts and lunches is not included in the annual tuition and fees and operates off of a declining balance account. Student lunch accounts are automatically set up for your family through FACTS. As parents, you can add any amount of money you desire to your child(ren)'s accounts through your Family Portal. As your child(ren) eats on campus, we will deduct the cost from your account and notify you when your balance is around \$10.00.

SCHOOL WITHDRAWAL POLICY AND FEE

Parents withdrawing students after June 1 will be required to pay the portion of the school year completed in addition to a minimum of one quarter's tuition. This policy is necessary due to the commitments Wesleyan has already made for personnel, supplies, curriculum, and materials based on your child's enrollment.
