| New Student Enrollment Fee | \$475.00 | Paid per applicant and due at the time of acceptance. Payable through our online Enrollment Portal. | This one-time, nonrefundable fee includes new curriculum, upgrades to school security, facility enhancements, and technology improvements. |
| Continuous Enrollment Fee* | \$275.00 | Paid per student and drafted ever year in mid-February. | Wesleyan follows a continuous enrollment process that automatically re-enrolls all current eligible TK-11th grade students year after year until graduation. |

*If a student will not be returning to school the following year, parents are required to submit Wesleyan's online School Withdrawal Form by **FEB 1** to avoid being charged the continuous enrollment fee.

EXPLANATION OF ACADEMIC FEES

The annual academic fee amounts above cover student accident insurance, textbook rental, workbooks, yearbooks, elementary class shirt (TK-4), original set of gym clothes (6), CPR class (9), science/STEM/computer lab fees, Chromebook fees, annual achievement testing (TK-8), and PSAT testing (9-12).

The annual academic fees above DO NOT cover school lunches, after-school care, extended care, class/school field-trips, AP classes, Resource/Enrichment classes (for Academy students), graduation fees (12), private studio lessons, or athletic fees.

FLIK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DINING

Flik provides Wesleyan students with fresh, hot meals on a daily basis. The cost of our optional breakfasts and lunches are not included in the annual tuition/fees and operates off of a declining balance account. Student lunch accounts are automatically set up for your family through FACTS. As parents, you are able to add any amount of money you desire to your child(ren)'s lunch accounts through the Family Portal system. As your child(ren) eat on campus, we will simply deduct it from your account and notify you when your balance is around \$10.00.

SCHOOL WITHDRAWAL POLICY AND FEE

Parents withdrawing students after June 1 will be required to pay the portion of the school year completed in addition to a minimum of one quarter's tuition. This policy is necessary due to the commitments Wesleyan has already made for personnel, supplies, curriculum, and materials based on your child's enrollment. Unfortunately, there are no exceptions to this school board policy.
