



STUDENT DRESS CODE

WCA has implemented the following dress code. Parents and students, please familiarize yourselves with these policies. We appreciate your assistance in implementing these policies as we partner together.

DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES TK-12

Please refer to Divisional Dress Code Policies for specific information regarding shorts.

Pants/Jeans

- Well fitted pants may only be worn with tops, dresses, or skirts offering full coverage of hips, top of thighs, and rear.
- Tears and holes in pants must not be above mid-thigh.
- Pajama pants are not acceptable.

Shirts

- Shirts must cover the chest, shoulders (3 finger width), back, and midriff with no skin visible between the top and pants.
- Transparent/see-through tops are not acceptable.
- Pajama pants are not acceptable.

Dress/Skirts/Shorts

- Must reach mid-thigh.

Hats/Headgear

- Neither hats nor hoods may be worn in the school building during the school day.
- Earbuds are not to be worn during the school day.

Other

No extreme haircuts or piercings. Clothing with logos, symbols and slogans that are not edifying will not be allowed. Final decisions are at the discretion of the administration.

SPECIFIC DIVISIONAL DRESS CODE POLICIES

TK-5th

- **Shorts:** Boys and girls may wear loose-fitting shorts of modest length, with no holes.
- **Leggings:** Girls in TK-5 may wear well-fitted cotton or athletic leggings with a shirt or dress that covers bottom.
